Wisdom of The Dialogue of St. Catherine

Summary of Chapter 37. [See the 30 Oct bulletin online to put this summary into context.] The second of three reproofs (corrections, warnings) from God is the point of death. At death, the soul sees its guilt and shame (“worm of conscience”). If a soul is truly sorry for her sins because she offended God—and not because of the sufferings of hell which she deserves—the soul will still find mercy. If not, eternal damnation awaits.

Regarding refusing God’s mercy, God the Father says: “This is that sin which is never forgiven, now or ever: the refusal, the scorning of My mercy. For this offends me more than all other sins they have committed.” The despair of Judas was worse than his betrayal. Those who remain in their sins and reject mercy are slaves to selfish sensuality and will be punished with the devil and by the devil. [Note: St. Catherine was serious about salvation. We have always asked everyone to receive God’s mercy in Confession and pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.]
