Wisdom of the Dialogue of St. Catherine of Siena

Summary of Chapter 48. God’s servants feel no grief in suffering because they are stripped of their own will and closed in God’s. They, by God’s grace, are satisfied. In contrast, wretched souls “in one way or another have identified with the earth in their love, and so they have in fact become earth themselves.” God says, “Some in their great indecency make brute beasts of their bodies.” “And the more disordered their love in possessing, the greater is their grief in loss.”

“How many are the pains of a troubled conscience! How many are the pains of those who hunger for revenge! They gnaw away at themselves constantly, and they have killed themselves even before they kill their enemies: They are themselves the first to die, slain by their own hand with the knife of hatred.” “They crucify themselves with their own perverse will.” They become “martyrs of the devil.”
