Helping Our Family in Cameroon

Fr. Mathias came to Grand county from Cameroon (by way of Rome and Aurora). Next weekend we have an opportunity to help his home diocese. This year we will help provide wells in the village of Kocass.

The Republic of Cameroon formed in the 1960s from both French and British colonies. Both French and English are official languages, though more than 250 different languages are spoken in the country. About 70% of the population is Christian and 25% Muslim. Natural features include beaches, deserts, mountains, rainforests, and savannas. It is slightly larger than the state of California and is home to nearly 25 million people.

Many people live in poverty, with 24% of the population living below the international poverty threshold of \$1.90 a day in 2014. Many of the villages in his diocese don't have reliable sources of drinking water. The diocese of Eseka is about 1/3 larger than Grand County in area with 1/4 the number of Catholics in the Archdiocese of Denver.
