#### **The Message of Divine Mercy in This Year of Mercy**

1. Venerate the Image of Divine Mercy. Jesus said: “By means of this Image, I shall be granting many graces to souls; so let every soul have access to it” [*Diary*, 570].

2. Prepare your heart for the Feast of Divine Mercy—the Sunday after Easter. Jesus stated, “...whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment” [300].

3. Pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy every day. Jesus says: “The souls that say this Chaplet will be embraced by My mercy during their lifetime and especially at the hour of their death” [754].

4. The Hour of Mercy begins at 3 p.m. Our Lord Jesus promoted prayer at this time. He promised St. Faustina: “In this hour you can obtain everything for yourself and

others for the asking; it was the hour of grace for the whole world—mercy triumphed over justice” [1572].

5. All of us need to spread the message of Divine Mercy to the whole world. Jesus told St. Faustina: “Souls who spread the honor of My Mercy I shield through their entire life as a tender mother her infant, and at the hour of death, I will not be a Judge for them, but the Merciful Savior” [1075]. Our attitude must be one of faith, trust in God, and growth in mercy.
