-Sat, St. Ignatius, 6 – 6:45 p.m. (after Mass) **[Recall that Mass begins at 5 p.m. this particular weekend because both your priests have to be at the Cathedral in Denver in the morning for the ordination of new priests.]**  
-Sat, St. Anne, 4 – 5 p.m. (before Mass)  
-Sun, Our Lady, 8:30 – 9:30 a.m. (before Mass)  
-Sun, St. Peter, 11 a.m. – 12 p.m. (after Mass)
