And in this solitude, they gain strength; they draw their strength from God alone. With humility, but also with courage, they stand firmly in the face of all the storms that beat upon them. Like high-towering oaks, they are unmoved.

The nightclub shooting in Orlando last weekend is an evil situation. I spent an hour in front of the Tabernacle with Jesus on Tuesday praying for the dead, the wounded, and all family members and friends. I felt the sadness of the Heart of Jesus. I asked that all those who died reconciled with God and accepted Divine Mercy before meeting Jesus face to face.

Since life is short and none of us knows our last day, we should do everything to glorify God <u>daily</u> and be spiritually ready to meet Jesus at any time. In general, we should think about five things. We should strive to (1) increase our faith, (2) improve our prayer lives, (3) live God's commandments, (4) go frequently to the sacraments of the Eucharist and Confession, and (5) do charitable acts to build up God's Kingdom. These five are the ordinary means to grow in holiness.
