**Gems of Wisdom from the Diary of Saint Faustina**

**866.** During Vespers, I heard these words: My daughter, **I want to repose in you heart, because many souls have thrown Me out of their hearts today.** I have experienced sorrow unto death. I tried to comfort the Lord by offering Him my love a thousand times over. I felt, within my soul, a great disgust for sin.

**872.** January 7. During the Holy Hour, the Lord allowed me to taste His Passion. I shared in the bitterness of the suffering that filled His soul to overflowing. Jesus gave me to understand how a soul should be faithful to prayer despite torments, dryness, and temptations; because oftentimes the realization of God’s great plans depends mainly on such prayer. If we do not persevere in such prayer, we frustrate what the Lord wanted to do through us and within us. **Angelology**

The Feast Days for the Archangels (September 29) and the Guardian Angels (October 2) are coming soon. So let’s discuss a few points about angels this month and in the upcoming year. We will rely heavily on Dr. Peter Kreeft’s book *Angels and Demons*, mostly by summarizing various questions posed in it.

The study of angels (angelology) is a science, but not an empirical science. It uses a scientific method of gathering data and formulating theories to explain the data. The data about angels comes from (1) Biblical accounts and (2) human accounts of meeting angels. Accepting the Biblical accounts as data requires faith. Accepting thousands of human stories about encounters with angels requires trust in the persons explaining their experiences.

From the Bible and from people, we see that angels are (1) creatures of God, (2) bodiless spirits, (3) with intelligence and will, (4) who live in God’s presence in heaven, (5) obey His will, (6) carry His messages, (7)

assume bodies as we assume costumes, (8) influence our imagination but not our will, and (9) move material things supernaturally sometimes.

There are many people today who do not believe that God has sent us guardian angels and other angels to help us because of the philosophy of naturalism within our culture. Naturalism denies the supernatural: “If I cannot see it, I don’t believe it exists.”
