

Daily Mass Reading from September 11

The following reading appears every other year during a weekday Mass. Therefore, many never see or hear it. It is important to think about what it is saying. The reading is **1 Corinthians 6:9-11**.

Do you not know that the unjust will not inherit the Kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators nor idolaters nor adulterers nor boy prostitutes nor homosexuals nor thieves nor the greedy nor drunkards nor slanderers nor robbers will inherit the Kingdom of God. That is what some of you used to be; but now you have had yourselves washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God.

So we see, God is speaking through Paul, saying that if one persists in sin and does not repent, he/she jeopardizes his/her salvation. So, if anyone has committed any of these sins and has never gone to confession for them, he/she should go to confession and become washed and sanctified (= receive sanctifying grace from the sacrament) and justified (= in right relationship with God).

This reading also shows that, by accepting God's grace daily, one can stop sinning and get out of various habits and lifestyles of sin—that is what some of you used to be.

It would be great if this reading were read at Mass once a year for Sunday readings so that more people would hear God's truth. It would make people think before they fell into sin. So many people do not read the **Basic Instructions Before Leaving Earth**. We need to know the truth in order to be saved. We want all people to get to heaven; we love everyone.
