Love is Patient; Love is Kind...it is not Quick-Tempered, it does not Brood over Injury

Instead of any of us getting angry or gossiping about our wounds, we could follow this 4-step approach:

1. Surrender your agitation regarding a person or situation to the Lord. E.g., “Lord, I surrender my anger and frustration regarding _____ to You.”
2. Re-consecrate yourself to God. “God, instead of letting this agitation (name it) rule my life, I choose to re-consecrate myself to You. And so I pray: Holy Mary, Our Lady of Fatima, with renewed gratitude for your maternal presence, I join my voice to all generations who call you blessed. Hold my life in your arms: Ask the Lord to bless and strengthen my every desire for good; revive and nourish my faith; sustain and enlighten my hope; awaken and animate charity within me; guide me along the path of holiness. Ever-Virgin Mary, bring me under your protection and entrust me to your beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.”
3. Pray briefly for the person or situation to get better.
4. If the agitation continues, do something life-giving (pray more, go for a walk and pray, clean the house, ask someone if you can help him/her, give your children a hug, etc.). This will help you to grow in virtue (repeated good acts). Don’t re-enforce the vice by telling “your story” over and over and falling into self-pity and over-sensitivity. Ask Jesus, through Mary, to heal your emotions.

Wisdom of The Dialogue of St. Catherine

Summary of chapter 4. When we go to confession, we are forgiven. However, we must repair the damage of the sin with the Lord’s help. We must make atonement. God the Father: **“Those who have heartfelt contrition, love for true patience, and that**

true humility which considers oneself worthy of punishment and unworthy of reward, suffer with patience and so make atonement.”

Charity gives life to virtue; charity is nursed/mothered by humility. Have true patience, sorrow for sin, love of virtue—all for the glory and praise of God’s name.

Sufferings endured, through charity, bring atonement/reward for self/others. Others will be pardoned in proportion to their receptiveness.
