Feast Day of St. Bernard of Montjoux, June 15

St. Bernard's church in Fraser is named after an 11th century churchman who had founded hospices in Alpine passes to help the many travelers and pilgrims passing through. This year we celebrate our patron's feast day Saturday, June 12.

The current St Bernard's Church is the result of an accident in 1901, when a broken wheel on a wagon carrying Jesuit priests and brothers back to Denver stopped them in front of Billy and Mary Cozens' ranch house. This began a long friendship between the family and the Jesuits. From 1944 until 1980, the Catholics who lived in the Fraser Valley mostly attended Mass at the Jesuit retreat area known as Maryvale, located on the land given to them by the Cozens family. Later Mass was celebrated in a cinema for 10 years (affectionately know as "Our Lady of the Cinema"). Eventually the Jesuits gave a few acres of the Maryvale property to the Archdiocese of Denver, and archdiocesan priests began to be the primary ministers to the Fraser community. On April 18, 1983, Archbishop James Casey gave permission to call the Catholic community of this valley St. Bernard of Montjoux. The dining hall of the retreat area was converted into the current church, which was dedicated on August 19, 1990.
