# **Helping Our Family in Cameroon**

Fr. Mathias came to Grand county from Cameroon (by way of Rome and Aurora). Next weekend we have an opportunity to help his home diocese. This year we will help provide wells in the village of Makak.

The Republic of Cameroon formed in the 1960s from both French and British colonies. Both French and English are official languages, though more that 250 different languages are spoken in the country. About 70% of the population is Christian and 25% Muslim. Natural features include beaches, deserts, mountains, rainforests, and savannas. It is slightly larger than the state of California and is home to nearly 25 million people. They also have a pretty good soccer/football team that is playing in the FIFA World Cup this year. (Their first game is next Thursday at 3 a.m. our time.)

Many people live in poverty, with 24% of the population living below the international poverty threshold of \$1.90 a day in 2014. Many of the villages in his diocese don't have reliable sources of drinking water. The diocese of Eseka is about 1/3 larger than Grand County in area with 1/4 the number of Catholics

in the Archdiocese of Denver.

Our second collection next weekend, and \$10,000 from the parish tithing fund, will be sent to Cameroon ahead of Fr. Mathias' trip there in January. You can also mail in a check or put it in the collection next weekend.
