

### **Eucharistic Revival and 24-Hours Adoration**

The Bishops of the United States have launched an exciting initiative called the National Eucharistic Revival. The Eucharistic Revival has the stated mission to “renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.” All dioceses in the United States are invited to participate in this three-year initiative to increase Eucharistic devotion among the faithful and spread the Gospel message to those who have not yet received it, and the Archdiocese of Denver will be participating in full.

The Eucharistic Revival will be integral in helping the Church to put on an apostolic mindset by calling us to divine intimacy, without which no one could ever see as God sees nor love as he loves. In the Archdiocese of Denver, the Eucharistic Revival will launch this Advent. It will kick-off with an Advent preaching series on the Eucharist and charity. We will also begin with a period of prayer with 24 hours of Eucharistic Adoration. At Our Lady of the Snow, from the evening of Nov. 26 and ending the evening of Nov. 27, every parishioner is invited to spend an hour with our Lord. More information will come next weekend.
