## The Novena to the Divine Mercy Begins on Good

### Friday, March 29

Jesus: *My great delight is to unite Myself with souls... When I come to a human heart in Holy Communion, My hands are full of all kinds of graces which I want to give to the soul.* —Diary, 1385

The Novena to the Divine Mercy is a great prayer to ask for the salvation of all people. It has a plenary indulgence attached to it. You may ask God to apply the plenary indulgence to a soul in purgatory. To observe the Feast of Mercy well, which is the Sunday after Easter, and to gain a plenary indulgence, we should:

1) Celebrate the Feast on Divine Mercy Sunday, 2) venerate the Image of the Divine Mercy, 3) be merciful to others, through our actions, words, and prayers on their behalf, 4) place our complete trust in Jesus, 5) have the intention of gaining a plenary indulgence, 6) pray the novena that follows, 7) detach ourselves from all sin, 7) go to Confession, preferably before the Feast [we may go within 20 days before or after the Feast, according to previously issued norms for plenary indulgences], 8) pray an Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be for the intentions of Pope Francis, and 9) receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast.
