Helping Our Family in Cameroon

Fr. Mathias came to Grand county from Cameroon (by way of Rome and Aurora). Next weekend we have an opportunity to help his home diocese. This year we are raising funds to help the villages of Song-Badjeck, Mom-Gare, Minka, and Makak.

Many people in Cameroon live in poverty, with 24% of the population living below the international poverty threshold of \$1.90 a day in 2014. Many of the villages in his diocese don't have reliable sources of drinking water.

His home diocese of Eseka is about 1/3 larger than Grand County in area with 1/4 the number of Catholics in the Archdiocese of Denver.

Our second collection next weekend will be sent to Cameroon ahead of Fr. Mathias' trip there in January. You can also mail in a check or put it in the collection the following weekend. Thank you for your generosity!
